Further Information

- West Chiltington Community School currently have their best ever sports offer in terms of extra-curricular clubs and sporting opportunities.
- Most of our clubs are closely associated with local community clubs, providing a next step for children who are enjoying and achieving well in those sports: there are local table tennis, squash, tennis, netball, cricket and rugby clubs all with coaches who currently work at our school.
- Some classes have / are exploring using yoga as a means of promoting calmness, balance, strength and wellbeing in the children. We are planning on inviting a professional yoga teacher into school to train our staff to deliver yoga sessions to all our children.
- Following Sports Fair July 2017, year 5 are receiving squash coaching (funded from PE budget allocation) from Kelly Eastment (West Worthing Squash Club). Currently 2 children have gone on to attend coaching sessions at West Worthing Squash Club as a result of this. An inter-schools tournament, which West Chiltington will take part in, is planned for summer term 2018 at West Worthing Squash Club.
- Members of the table tennis club have, and are currently, taking part in Horsham and District schools' table tennis league.
- Four members of West Chiltington School also play at West Chiltington Table Tennis Club.
- Some members of the school netball club are now also playing at Chanctonbury Netball Club.
- A STARS schools cricket tournament is planned for summer term 2018, to be run by cricket coach Tim van Noort.
- STARS schools taster sessions and tournaments continue to run throughout the year. As of autumn term 2017, a West Sussex minibus now takes the children to these events, easing pressure on parents to provide transport and allowing a smoother and safer journey our school to the host schools.
- Separate STARS schools football and netball tournaments are planned for 2017-18 for able pupils.

Forest Schools

A Forest Schools trained, qualified teacher is delivering Forest Schools to reception class (since November 2017) and is now also delivering to year 3 (since January 2018). Funding has come from PE budget allocation.

Jill Dinsdale (year 3 teacher) is to undertake full Forest Schools training to be able to deliver it in our school in the interests of sustainability. This will be funded from the PE budget.

As a further development, reception and year 3 will be using Forest Schools as basis for future buddy activities.
